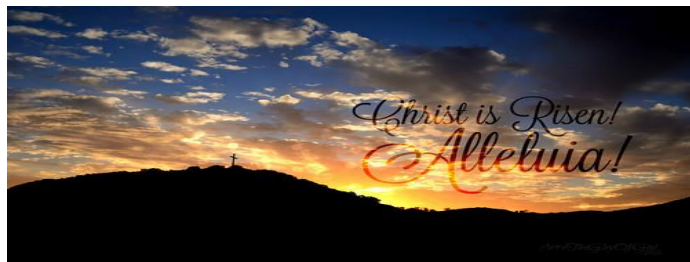

Ann Behan Plume Herron was a wealthy Norfolk Catholic from a slave-owning family. When the rest of her relations fled the area during the 1855 yellow fever epidemic, she chose to stay behind to care for slaves stricken with the disease. She also turned her home over to the Daughters of Charity, allowing them to use it as a hospital for victims of the epidemic.

Easter Theme -Isaiah 49

In Isaiah 49 (paraphrased by Carey Landry)

"I will never forget you my people. I have carved you in the palm of my hand." The people of Judah were held in exile. They felt the Lord God had forgotten them. The Lord, however, had accompanied them. Some of the best prayers and scripture come from the exile event.
