2019-2020 Expectations and Standards

1. We will provide a polite and fun environment for all to learn. All students are welcome to our classes including family and friends who are not Catholic. Ultimately, the glory and exaltation of God is the end of all things, including elementary-age Sunday school classes.
2. Class begins at 10:00 and ends at 10:45. Because of Diocese and Virtus regulations, you must pick your child up at the classroom at 10:45. For everyone's Safety, students cannot be allowed to leave on their own.
3. Parents are the first teachers of the children ¹. We encourage you to pray and discuss with your children what they learned. Together, we will help them grow in the faith.
4. Any child wanting or needing sacraments, Kassandra or John must be informed prior to December 31, 2019 to ensure needs are met.
5. Children are required to attend all classes. If you are unable to attend it is OK, but attendance is needed especially if they are preparing for sacraments.
6. There can be, at times, difficult subjects we may touch on. Kassandra and John will always teach the Catholic position on subjects. If you feel the need to discuss matters privately, we can plan for that.
7. As their faith deepens and they become older, the subjects will develop as well. The Middle and High school aged students will explore topics like Philosophy, Theology, Christology, Ethics, and the Saints. All will be age appropriate with the intent of deepening their understanding of our faith.
