Parish Donations and Annual Tax Statement:

As we start a new calendar (and tax) year, we want you to be aware how donations are included in your <u>Donation Annual Tax Statement</u> from this Parish.

If you are registered with the Parish (have an envelope number), and your donation goes through regular collections (i.e. Sunday Collections) or are mailed into the office – then your donations will be included in your annual tax statement regardless of where you designate them to be applied to (i.e.: regular parish operations, capital improvements, Poverty Fund, Ladies Guild, etc.). All *designated donations* are set aside for the specific purpose they were intended for and are not used in the day to day operations of the Parish.

If you give monies directly to the Poverty Fund or the Ladies Guild, those donations <u>will</u> <u>not</u> be included in your annual tax statement. Our current accounting software and family suite programs cannot accommodate this task at this time.

Either way is fine. It is your choice how you want to donate to the Poverty Fund and the Ladies Guild. My purpose is only to let you know what will be included in your Annual Tax Statement.

Also, Fr. Jim may send a letter acknowledging a gift/donation. This letter can be used when filing your income tax returns.
