Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 Years:

(for January 19th)

The diocese of Richmond was established because a lay delegation fooled Roman officials with a deliberately inflated account of the state's Catholic population. The first bishop of Richmond, Patrick Kelly, took less than a year both to correct Rome's misconceptions and to get transferred to another diocese. As a result, from 1822 to 1841 Rome left Richmond without a bishop.
