Memorable Moments in Diocesan History

John Carroll, who would shortly become America’s first bishop, in 1785 sent officials in Rome the first detailed picture of Catholicism in the newly founded United States. He estimated that the state of Virginia contained just 200 Catholics. The Virginia faithful received the sacraments only “four or five times a year,” when a priest was able to travel down from Maryland.

The Diocese of Richmond is pleased to introduce the Office of Cemetery and Funeral Services to oversee cemetery operations, effective January 1, 2020. The existing Office of Cemeteries, which has assisted parishes through a contract with Catholic Funeral and Cemetery Services (CFCS) since 2016, will be reconfigured into the new office. Deacon Ed Handel, who currently serves as the Director of the Diocese’s Office of Cemeteries, will serve as the Director of Cemetery and Funeral Services.
