Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years Virginia Catholics spent much of the 1920s fighting the Ku Klux Klan. On April 14, 1924, the K.K.k. held a week-long mass rally in Harrisonburg, Virginia. The opening day, a speaker told the crowd the Catholic Church was "not a church, but a most dangerous and non-American political organization, acting behind stone walls, wearing its black gowns and receiving orders across the water, most of whom are opposed to Americanism."
