Sunday and Holy Days Mass Obligation:

Following is a portion of the statement from the Bishops of the Province of Baltimore of which the Diocese of Richmond is a part (regarding COVID Mass Dispensation).

"....we are lifting the dispensation of the Sunday and Holy Days Mass obligations...and reinstating that obligation beginning on Saturday, June 26, 2021 and Sunday, June 27, 2021. We encourage the Faithful to return to full in-person participation of the Sunday Eucharist, the source and summit of our Catholic faith...."

"This obligation does not apply to those who are ill; those who have reason to believe that they were recently exposed to the coronavirus, another serious or contagious illness; those who are confined to their home, a hospital, or nursing facility; or those with serious underlying health conditions. One should consult his or her local pastor if questions arise about the obligation to attend Mass..."
