Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years In 1924, the Knights of Columbus fought back against anti-Catholic propaganda in Virginia by creating their own newspaper, the *Virginia Knight*. After Catholic Al Smith's 1928 presidential candidacy produced a spike in anti-Catholic incidents, Bishop Andrew Brennan (1926-1934) determined that the diocese needed its own newspaper to defend itself. Hence, in 1931, the diocese purchased the *Virginia Knight*, which it renamed *The Catholic Virginian*. So the 1920s battle between the Catholic Church and the K.K.K. still affects your mailbox 100 years later.
