Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years

Wales Tyrrell, an African American Catholic convert and public school teacher, was brought before the Charlottesville school board in February 1887 to face charges of misconduct. The charges: “being a Catholic” and permitting “a Catholic priest” to speak “in his school room.” When Tyrrell defended himself on the grounds of freedom of religion, the chairman of the school board replied that in Charlottesville Catholicism “is not regarded as [a] religion.” Tyrrell would eventually found a Catholic school for African American in Keswick, Virginia.
