Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years

St. Katharine Drexel—the Philadelphia heiress who became a nun and spent her life in the service of those on the margins of society—also greatly contributed to the Catholic education of Virginia’s African Americans. With her sister, she in 1894 purchased 2,200 acres at Rock Castle on the James River in Powhatan County. Together they founded St. Francis’ (for boys) and St. Emma’s (for girls), collectively intended to be a “Catholic Tuskegee,” schools which would offer a sound education while teaching children trades that would help them provide for their families.
