### **Memorable Moments in Diocesan History**

Bishop Russell's work for social justice included a commitment to fair housing and to integrating racially segregated neighborhoods. In 1965, he worked with Rabbi Noah Golinkin and the Protestant Minister Rev. David Colwell to organize a convocation on Fair Housing that was attended by Stewart Udall, the Secretary of the Interior. At the conclusion of the convocation, a formal statement in favor of Fair Housing was signed by 15,000+ members of all three faiths.

### **Thankful for the Work of Dr. Chene Heady**

Dr. Chene Heady, a professor at Longwood University in Farmville, has been submitting a weekly paragraph on our diocesan history which is shared in our bulletin. We hope you have enjoyed them. Dr. Chene has presented on EWTN and has been the Parish Council Chairperson at Our Lady of Peace during the past three years. He is a real gift to the Father McEleney Cluster.
