Memorable Moments in Diocesan History - 1820 Bicentennial 2020 – 200 years

John Keane—the fifth bishop of Richmond (1878 to 1888)—was the first of our bishops to prioritize outreach to African Americans. Less than fifteen years after the end of the Civil War, he personally said mass for and taught catechism to Richmond's African American community. Undeterred by the anti-Catholic backlash these efforts created, he also began creating schools and churches for the African American population throughout the diocese.
