

THANK YOU ALL FOR SUPPORTING OUTREACH MINISTRIES IN 2024.

Thank you for being Christ's light and love to those who come to St. Victoria for help. During 2024 St. Victoria Outreach Ministries, with God's grace and your support, accomplished the following:

- **1.** We made 34 pledges to help those families avoid disconnection of utilities. This allowed 157 individuals to have lights, heat and air-conditioning.
- **2**. We helped 2,280 individuals with food through our weekly Food Pantry service (1,309 adults and 971 children).
- **3**. We helped staff for SPARK one day for the summer reading, activity, snack and food program. Our volunteers assisted with activity, snack, distributing free reading books, and purchasing/packing/distributing bags of food.
- **4.** For Thanksgiving we distributed 48 turkey breasts and 2 donated turkeys to those in need.
- **5.** For Christmas, we distributed 59 food boxes and winter clothing/gifts for 81 Christmas Angels: 48 Angels from the Community, 14 Angels from Hurt Elementary School, 11 Angels from Altavista Elementary School and 8 Angels from Altavista Combined School. Angels were sponsored by Outreach, Ladies Guild, Prayer Shawl Group, Parishioners, Friends of the Church and donations.
